TARGETED CAPACITY EXPANSION FOR SUB ABUSE TREATMENT & HIV/AIDS SERVICES

Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration - Next Deadline: May 16, 2006. Program aims to enhance and expand substance abuse treatment and/or outreach and pretreatment services in conjunction with HIV/AIDS services in African American, Latino/Hispanic, and/or other racial or ethnic communities highly affected by the twin epidemics of substance abuse and HIV/AIDS. Up to \$5.3 million will be available to fund up to 10-12 awards in FY06. Annual awards may be \$500,000 per year for up to 5 yrs.
